

Rubber Workers Information Session

What you need to bring to the event, March 28 and 29, 2019

- Name and contact information for your family physician and specialists
- Name and contact information for your advocate, if you have one

- Any doctor's reports or medical information about your health issue or diagnosis
- Any pathology (biopsy) reports – these are the documents which contain your diagnosis
- Any specialist reports
- All medical test results relating specifically to your condition, such as:
 - X-ray reports
 - Pulmonary function test (PFT) reports
 - Results from a CT scan or an MRI scan
 - Operating room reports
- All related bloodwork results if the diagnosis is a blood cancer
- A list of all your medications

- Power of Attorney for Health Care, as appropriate

- **Your Work History**
 - Where have you worked?
 - In which department?
 - For how long?
 - Did you do overtime?
 - A list of chemicals or materials with which you worked or to which you were exposed
 - A list of the work processes you were involved in or worked beside

- If you have a denied claim with the **Workplace Safety and Insurance Board (WSIB)**:
 - Any correspondence with respect to the denied claim, including the denial letter
 - A copy of your WSIB file

If you are registering a **worker who is deceased**, in addition to the list above, please bring:

- A copy of the first and the last page of the deceased's will
- As executor/executrix, you will be asked to sign the OHCOW consent forms.
